statistics

in 1948, israel committed over 70 massacres and killed 15,000 palestinians during nakba

the nakba has made the gaza strip the most crowded place in the world at 3,881 individuals per square km

israeli restrictions deprive palestinians of using more than one-third of the west bank

palestinians consume less than half the appropriate amount of water per day due to restrictions (30-50 litres)

on average 58% of palestinians live below the poverty line. in the gaza strip, that number is 79%

palestine ranks at 108 on the worldwide scale in regards to prevention of infant mortality

chronic malnutrition affects 10% of children below the age of 5
